



## Call for abstracts Exoplanets 5

**Deadline: 15 November 2023, 23.59 hrs. CET.**

You are cordially invited for the Exoplanets 5 conference in Leiden, The Netherlands, 16-22 June 2024. The Exoplanets Conference Series (Davos 2016; Cambridge 2018, Heidelberg 2020, Las Vegas 2022) has developed into one of the most important and largest meetings in the field, with 750 participants expected in Leiden.

The conference covers all aspects of exoplanet science, from detection methods and demographics to planet interiors and atmospheric characterization, from planet formation and evolution, to star-planet interactions and exoplanet instrumentation. There will be special attention to the newest and most exciting JWST results.

Leiden is a charming university town, in the heart of western Europe, well connected by rail and Amsterdam airport. The conference will take place in the Stadsgehoorzaal, in the middle of Leiden's historic center with its many 17<sup>th</sup>-century canals and cobblestone streets. Since meetings like these have a large impact on the environment, we encourage everyone to look at combining your visit with other meetings, work visits, or holidays. We will have an action-packed week of presentations (please apply for a talk/poster), in addition to a very exciting list of invited keynote speakers. Equally important, there will be plenty of time to meet and interact with all your colleagues of our global exoplanet community. Do not forget the Welcome Reception on Sunday, and the *Big Exoplanets 5 Solar-Solstice Party™* in the Botanic Gardens on Thursday night!

## Submission procedure

1. Please submit your abstract electronically by **15 November 2023, 23.59 hrs. CET**.
2. All submissions will be acknowledged on receipt. If you do not receive an acknowledgement by email within a couple of minutes, please check your spam folder first and then [contact](#) us.
3. All abstract submissions must be in English. All talks and posters should be in English as well.
4. Authors will be notified about the final decision of the scientific committee on 1 February 2024. If their submission is accepted, authors will be informed about its accepted format and the preliminary scheduled date and time of the presentation.
5. At least one presenting author of each accepted abstract is required to register as participant by 1 March 2024, 23.59 CET to be included in the final programme.
6. Presenters and authors are not eligible for a registration discount.
7. All submissions will be anonymously reviewed by members of the scientific committee. The scientific committee will decide on acceptance or rejection as a talk or poster.
8. The text of the accepted and programmed abstracts along with the names and affiliations of the (co-) authors will be published on the conference website and in the conference app.

## Submission structure

★ **Title** (max. 15 words)

★ **Submission format**

• Talk

A talk of 10-12 minutes about research and the results followed by 3-5 minutes questions/discussion. Multiple talks are grouped together around a category in one session as much as possible.

• Poster presentation

Posters provide an ideal opportunity to engage with the audience on issues under development: methodology, proposed or ongoing research as well as presenting research results with an emphasis on collegial discussion and feedback.

Posters will be on display on multiple days during the conference. The programme includes poster break and lunches in the poster area. Presenters are encouraged to be available at their poster for questions and/or discussion. The poster should be size A0, portrait: 84,1 cm (width) x 118,9 cm (height).
